This is accomplished through an annual induction ceremony that is held in various sites of the country, depending on local interest and sponsorship. The hall chronicles the visions, tenacity and courage of the inductees for the benefits of future generations of entrepreneurs.

Qualifications:

The MBHF&M anticipates that there are two types of individuals —entrepreneurs and former employees that were engaged in minority business development and related areas — that will be nominated for induction. Entrepreneurs who are still engaged with their business are eligible for induction. However, former employees must be retired to be a valid candidate. Institutions are also eligible for induction.
